On E	On December 29, 2008 at approximately 1630, a flash fire occurred in the Molecular Sciences Building at the University of														
California Los Angeles. The incident occurred when the victim, SANGJI, was drawing t-butyl lithium from a bottle into a															
syrin	syringe and the plunger came out of the syringe barrel. The chemical, which ignites spontaneously in air, splashed onto														
SAN	SANGJI's clothing, setting them on fire. SANGJI received burns to 40% of her body and was initially treated at Ronald														
Rega	Regan UCLA Medical Center. She was subsequently transferred to the Grossman Burn Center in Sherman Oaks where she														
died	died from her injuries on January 16, 2009.														
Preli	Preliminary fire investigation was conducted by the Los Angeles City Fire Department at the time of the fire. Inasmuch as														
the fi	the fire scene had been compromised by the time I received notification, I was unable to conduct an investigation into the
